



## **How to Report Illegal Hunting**

Illegal hunting is a crime that is treated seriously by the Game Council NSW.

This conduct includes any hunting that occurs without regard for safety; without adequate training; without respect for the animals hunted; or that is non-compliant with Government regulations. Such conduct is unacceptable to other forest users, to landholders adjoining state forests, and to the general public.

It is in the interests of legitimate hunters, other forest users, and the community to report any information that can assist the Game Council in identifying and prosecuting illegal hunters.

**NOTE: Never confront suspected illegal hunters.**
